**NOTICE OF BOARD OF APPEALS JUDGE VACANCY**

Notice is hereby given that, due to the retirement of David F. Hensley, a Judge of the Workers' Compensation Appeals Board, effective March 31, 2022, the Governor's Office is accepting applications to fill that office until the expiration of his term, July 31, 2024, pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 50-6-218. Section 50-6-218 sets forth the qualifications for the office, providing that: "Workers' compensation judges shall be Tennessee licensed attorneys in good standing with at least seven (7) years' experience in workers' compensation matters and shall be at least thirty (30) years of age, and shall be required to attend annual training on workers' compensation laws."

To be considered for this appointment, interested attorneys should submit a resume and cover letter to the Governor's Office for consideration.
